

LOVINA TOUR

Temple Jagaraga, Market in Singaraja, Hot Springs, Buddhist Monastery

The Lovina tour starts from Alam Anda and goes along the coastal road to the north side of Bali, where you will visit the Temple Jagaraga with its interesting stories about the history of Bali. Then we will go to Singaraja which was the capital of Bali during the Dutch colonial supremacy. On some of the buildings you can still see the remains of the Colonial style. There you will visit the town centre and also experience the local market where you can buy many nice things. Afterwards you will drive to the Hot Springs of Banjar (don't forget your swimwear). The Hot Springs are located in the middle of a lush tropical forest - a beautiful setting. Finally you will visit the amazing and very important Buddhist Monastery close to Dencarik.
