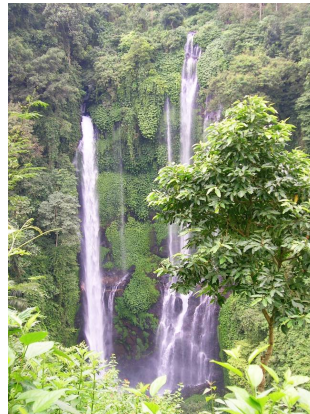


SINGARAJA TOUR

Tempel Meduwe Karang, Sekumpul Waterfall, Market in Singaraja

The route runs from the Alam Anda along the coast to the north side of Bali, where you will first visit the Hindu temple Meduwe Karang. The temple has images of the Dutch colonial period. If you already know this, alternatively the temple Jagaraga can be visited. Then it's on to the waterfall Sekumpul in Sawan. This waterfall is in an untouched landscape, reachable via 300 stairs! After the long way down you can refresh your feet while walking through the water stream. Afterwards you visit the local market in downtown Singaraja, where you have the opportunity to go shopping.



Start: Our tour starts from Alam Anda at 9:00 am, return will be around 3:00 pm.

To bring: Comfortable, slip resistant shoes (which can get wet), suitable clothes for the temple
